**We estimate an additional \$75 to \$100 for 4 meals and one night hotel with a shared room.**

We'll find a hotel as near the conference center as possible although I must warn you that my initial searches show nothing within walking distance. I've found nice hotels with good reviews for about \$69—\$89 per night which isn't bad when split with a roommate. :-)

We will focus our planning on attendees who would come down on Friday evening, attend the conference, spend Friday night and all day Saturday then return to Milwaukee Saturday evening after the conference. However, these are other options you might consider based on your schedule and budget.

**Extended Stay:** Stay overnight Friday AND Saturday and don't return until Sunday

**Saturday ONLY:** Go down Saturday morning, attend the conference, and come back to Milwaukee Saturday night

**Saturday Conf with overnight:** NOT attend Friday night but drive down early Saturday morning for the conference then stay Saturday night and return Sunday
